

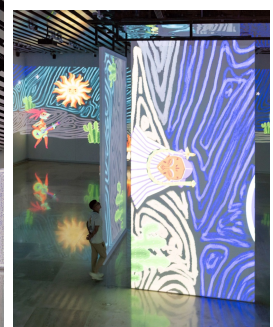
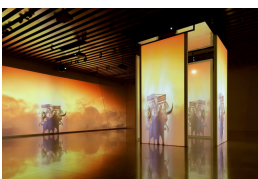


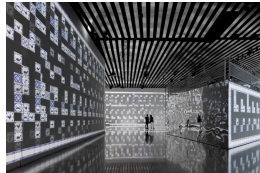
MUSEO INTERNACIONAL DEL BARROCO

The **Museo Internacional del Barroco**, located in Puebla, Mexico, and inaugurated in 2016, was designed by renowned Japanese architect Toyo Ito. Aiming to create exhibitions enhanced by interactive museography, the museum called upon XYZ Technologies to contribute to the video projection aspect.
